Oak Grove Children's Consignment Sale Tagging Information



Items accepted: All seasonally appropriate items accepted must pertain to children and be in great condition. Hang all clothing on hangers, buttoned, zipped, snapped, and tied where applicable. All pricing is in 50 cent increments. Attach tags printed on cardstock (must be scannable by our scanners!) with safety pins or a tagging gun or clear packing tape to non-clothing items. Consider grouping small items together in ziplocks. If you wish to offer your items at half price on Saturday, select the “discount” option while tagging. An asterisk (*) will print next to the price to designate ½ price. All unsold items will be available for pick up Saturday, March 21 from 4-5PM. Any items left at 5PM will be donated. If you wish to donate your unsold items please select the “donate” option when tagging to benefit Parents In Need or other community partners.

- 🌿 Children's clothing sizes, light jackets and swimsuits, all labeled with a numerical size 0-20
- 🌿 Costumes/dress up, dancewear, sports equipment and clothing
- 🌿 Maternity clothing, current styles, labeled XS-XXL

- 🌿 Children's shoes/accessories
- 🌿 Toys/Games/Puzzles/Books
- 🌿 Nursery or kids rooms furniture and décor
- 🌿 Baby Gear
- 🌿 Bathing/Bathroom equipment
- 🌿 Outdoor toys

Items NOT accepted:

Oak Grove United Methodist Church Children's Consignment Sale Consignor Agreement/Waiver

1. In consideration of Oak Grove United Methodist Church's (OGUMC) agreement to permit Consignor to participate in Children's consignment Sale, Consignor agrees to hold harmless and indemnify OGUMC, its employees, officers, directors, members and any volunteer or paid participants in the OGUMC Children's Consignment Sale from any claim, suit, or legal action of any kind arising out of damage, theft or loss of any items consigned to OGUMC Consignment Sale and for any personal injury incurred by consignor, for whatever cause, either foreseen or unforeseen, and regardless of OGUMC's negligence. OGUMC does not anticipate any thefts, damage, or loss or personal injury and will take reasonable security and safety precautions.
2. Consignor will receive 60% of the sales price on items that sell unless they volunteer. Volunteers who work one 3 hour shift will receive 70% of the sale price of items sold.
3. Buyers will be charged a 3% convenience fee for all credit card purchases made during the sale.
4. Consignor agrees that during the last day of the sale (Saturday, March 21), some items may be sold for half the price originally designated by the Consignor if the Consignor has marked for the item to discount at the half price sale by choosing item discount during the tag entry.
5. All goods left in the possession of OGUMC are at the sole risk of the Consignor. Consignor agrees that it shall assume and bear all risks regarding consigned goods, and will hold OGUMC exempt from any and all liability. Should items be lost, stolen or damaged, OGUMC is not responsible to compensate the Consignor for the items.
6. OGUMC reserves the right to reject any items if it does not meet the highest quality standards set in the "Item Preparation" instructions or is not within the appropriate sale season. Consignor agrees that unsold items marked for donation indicated on the tag will be donated or become property of OGUMC at the end of the sale. There are NO exceptions. Items not marked for donation must be picked up by the Consignor not later than 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 21, 2020, or they too will be subject to donation. **Any items that remain after the designated pickup time will either be donated or will become sole property of OGUMC.**
7. Items must be tagged and tags printed in accordance with our tagging guidelines, and as described in our tagging information document, which is attached to the consignor registration email. Copies are also available by email request at oakgrovepreschoolconsignment@gmail.com.
8. Any merchandise without a tag will not be sold. All merchandise that is without a tag that does not get claimed will automatically be donated or become property of OGUMC.
9. Consignor has reviewed recalled items on the CPSC website: www.cpsc.gov and verifies that to their knowledge, none of the items being submitted to the OGUMC Children's Consignment Sale has been recalled and that all meet the CPSC standards for children's products.
10. Consignor is responsible for verifying their mailing address, phone number, consignor number and e-mail address at time of check-in. All checks will be mailed within two weeks to the address provided.
11. Consignor warrants that (s)he is the owner of the items to be sold, and has full authority to sell such items.

By signing this agreement, you confirm that you have carefully read all guidelines and procedures explained in the Seller Instructions, and agree to the terms stated above. I have read the Consignor Agreement and I agree to all terms and conditions within these documents for the OGUMC Children's Consignment Sale.
